



## 2020 Better Together 50/50 Lottery Rules and Regulations

1. The 2020/2021 50/50 Better Together Lottery draws take place on a weekly basis throughout the 2020 calendar year with the first draw being held on April 1, 2020 and the last draw being held on Wednesday March 31, 2021.
2. The lottery is divided into two licence periods: April 2020 – June 2020 & July 2020- March 2021
3. To enter the staff lottery draw, an Enrollment Form must be completed and submitted to the Foundation office. The Enrollment Form is available for download at [trilliumgiving.ca](http://trilliumgiving.ca) (Give Support – Employee Giving – 50/50) or upon request at [5050@thp.ca](mailto:5050@thp.ca) or 905-848-7580 x 3336. ***New tickets will be eligible for the draw on the Wednesday after the next pay period, once the form is received at the Foundation office.***
4. To increase the number of tickets for a current participant, an Enrollment Form must be completed and submitted to the Foundation office. The Enrollment Form is available for download at [trilliumgiving.ca](http://trilliumgiving.ca) (Give Support – Employee Giving – 50/50) or upon request at [5050@thp.ca](mailto:5050@thp.ca) or 905-848-7580 x 3336. ***New tickets will be eligible for the draw on the Wednesday after the next pay period, once the form is received at the Foundation office.***
5. Tickets will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. In the event that the lottery sells out, a waiting list will be created. As tickets become available, they will be offered to people on the waiting list in the order the enrollment forms were received.
6. At the end of each lottery licence period all current ticket holders will be **automatically** enrolled in the next draw and their payroll deductions will continue. When a new lottery licences are issued, all lottery ticket purchasers will receive new lottery ticket numbers under the new licence numbers. All ticket purchasers will continue to participate in the weekly draws until such time as they notify Trillium Health Partners Foundation that they no longer want to participate.
7. To opt out of the 50/50 Better Together Lottery, participants can do so at any time by sending an email to [5050@thp.ca](mailto:5050@thp.ca). **Participants must allow a two (2) week processing period to opt out of the draw.** Should an employee opt out, the next person on the waiting list will receive that person's ticket number. To resume play, individuals must complete the Enrollment Form again and they will be accommodated on a first come, first serve basis, as tickets are available. No refunds will be issued for draws which have already occurred.



8. Actual prize amount varies with participation to a maximum of \$5,625.00 per ticket per draw based on 7,500 tickets printed. Should the amount of printed tickets increase, the maximum prize amount will be adjusted accordingly.
9. A maximum of **five (6) tickets** per participant per draw can be purchased.
10. Weekly draws take place every Wednesday at 9:00 am at the Trillium Health Partners Foundation office at 800-89 Queensway West, Mississauga, ON L5B 2V2.
11. Winners will be notified in person or by phone and/or email no later than end of day on the draw date by a representative of Trillium Health Partners Foundation. Winners will have the option of picking up their cheque at the Foundation office at 800-89 Queensway West, Mississauga, ON L5B 2V2 or having it mailed.
12. Winners will be posted on the Trillium Health Partners Foundation website at [trilliumgiving.ca](http://trilliumgiving.ca) and in the monthly e-communication to all active participants.
13. Participants must be 18 years of age or older.
14. In order to be eligible for the draw, tickets must be paid for prior to the draw date and time.
15. Trillium Health Partners employees are permitted to enter the draw through payroll deduction, cheque or cash.
16. Any THP staff member who is a new participant and is part time, casual or on leave of absence, are encouraged to pre-pay for their tickets to ensure each ticket is eligible for every draw. Should a participant want to stay in the lottery during a leave of absence, they may prepay for their tickets for the duration of their leave. THP volunteers are also permitted to enter the draw with pre-payment. Cheques are to be made payable to **Trillium Health Partners Foundation**. The Enrollment Form is available for download at [trilliumgiving.ca](http://trilliumgiving.ca) (Give Support – Employee Giving – 50/50) or upon request at [5050@thp.ca](mailto:5050@thp.ca) or 905-848-7580 x 3336. *Payment for 50/50 Lottery tickets by credit card is not permitted.* Lottery pre-payment is defined as payment in full for all lottery tickets at \$1.50 per week from the purchase date until the end of the licenced period (March 31).
17. Trillium Health Partners Foundation will hold ineligible (unpaid) ticket numbers for up to two consecutive draws. If an employee does not pay by the third draw, their ticket will be cancelled and that ticket will be offered to another individual. Trillium Health Partners Foundation will notify all lottery participants whose tickets are ineligible by email prior to cancelling their eligibility.



18. Trillium Health Partners Foundation Staff, Board members and THP physicians are not permitted to enter the draw.
19. Prizes not claimed within 6 months will be automatically donated back to Trillium Health Partners Foundation.
